CBME Resident Subcommittee

Terms of Reference

The CBME Resident Subcommittee is accountable to the CBME Learner Development Subcommittee. At least one of the co-chairs of CBME Resident Subcommittee will be a member of the CBME Learner Development Subcommittee.

Purpose:

The purpose of the Learner Development subcommittee is to:

- o Provide a forum for residents to share best practices encountered within their programs at various stages of implementation of CBME.
- Establish best practice material to be shared and reviewed by the CBME Learner
 Development Subcommittee for dissemination to all residents and programs.
- Support the development of resident leaders in CBME.
- Bring forward concerns from residents to the CBME Learner Development
 Subcommittee on a regular basis to inform the priorities and work plan of the CBME Learner Development Subcommittee.
- Coordinate and provide advice on materials and resources needed for postgraduate learners.

Membership:

- 2 Resident Co-Chairs (from two different specialties).
- One resident representative from each program, nominated by the program as a designated CBME Resident Lead

The committee will meet on a quarterly basis. An agenda will be developed and minutes circulated to all committee members. A quorum is represented by half of the membership of the committee. Decisions are to be made by consensus.
