# **CBME Implementation Subcommittee**

#### **Terms of Reference**

The CBME Implementation Subcommittee is accountable to the Competency Based Medical Education Executive Committee, Postgraduate Medical Education, Faculty of Health Sciences. The Chair of the CBME Implementation Subcommittee will be a member of the CBME Executive.

#### **Purpose:**

The purpose of the Implementation subcommittee is to:

- Provide guidance to the residency programs regarding best practices for resident assessment and remediation - to create a standard of excellence amongst the residency programs
- Assist with the standardization of key concepts of competency based medical education,
   e.g., implementation of the Competence Committee.
- Development / facilitate new assessment strategies.
- Advocate, advise, prioritize and make recommendations to PG MedSIS Operations regarding the IT development / enhancement of MedSIS as it relates to the competency based medical education dashboard.
- Recommend and advise regarding policy changes as it relates to resident assessment and competency based medical education.
- Support and encourage scholarship within PGME.
