Terms of Reference

The CBME Learner Development Subcommittee is accountable to the Competency Based Medical Education Executive Committee, Postgraduate Medical Education, Faculty of Health Sciences. The Chair of the CBME Learner Development Subcommittee will be a member of the CBME Executive.

Purpose:

The purpose of the Learner Development subcommittee is to:

- Develop a faculty-wide learner development strategy that will assist the programs at various stages of implementation of competency based medical education.
- Advise regarding learning modules, on-line resources, etc, needed for postgraduate learners.
- Develop communication strategies regarding CBME.
- Recommend and advise regarding policy changes as it relates to residents and competency based medical education.
- Ensure that strategies are in keeping with faculty development
- Liaise with Undergraduate Medical Education regarding undergraduate learner awareness.

Membership:

- Faculty Co-Chair and Resident Co-Chair
- Program Directors (2)
- Resident representatives (4 – which would include one representative from the regional campus)
- Representative from Undergraduate Medical Education
- Chair, Faculty Development – Corresponding Member

The committee will meet on a regular basis (e.g., monthly). An agenda will be developed and minutes circulated to all committee members. A quorum is represented by half of the membership of the committee. Decisions are to be made by consensus.
