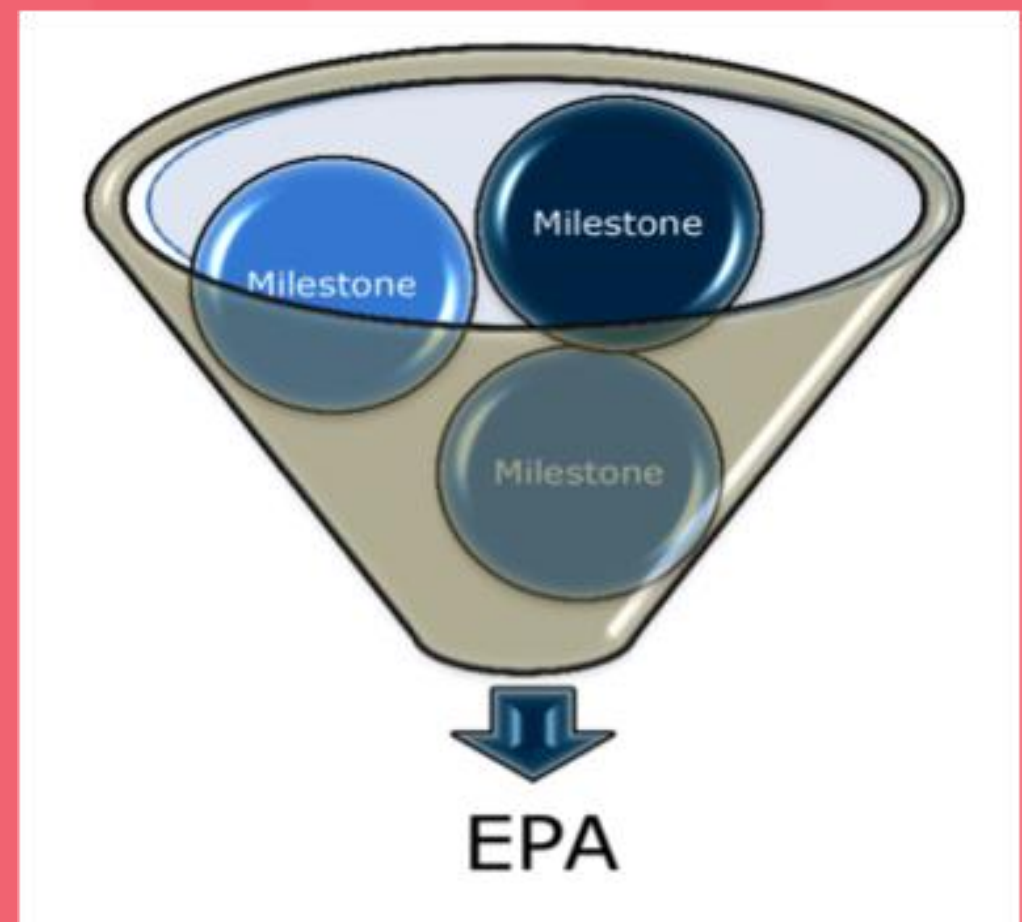

THE ENTRUSTABLE PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITIES

are the outcomes expected of a resident by the end of each stage of training.



An example of an EPA is:

"Assess, diagnose and participate in the management of patients with medical presentations, relevant to Psychiatry."

EPAs can be broken down into smaller, defined elements called **MILESTONES**.

Milestones:

- will reference the CanMEDS roles applicable to that EPA.
- can be used as observable markers of a resident's ability.
- can be used to guide feedback for improvement.

An example of a MILESTONE for the above EPA is:

"Demonstrates knowledge of potential medical causes of common psychiatric presentations."

The Royal College will define which EPAs a resident should successfully acquire during each stage of training.
